







New trends of sampling food in EU: milk and dairy products

Veterinary Faculty University of Zagreb as Croatian partner of FP7 BASELINE and PROMISE projects, in cooperation with Croatian Food Agency - HAH, is organizing this seminar in the premises of Croatian Chamber of Economy in Osijek.

The aim of the seminar is to disseminate the results of the BASELINE project, working package WP3 related to milk and dairy products. Its overall objective is to provide harmonized and validated sampling strategies, structured as International standard (ex. ISO), to support the European policies in food safety and to be suitable for food producers, in order to collect comparable data to improve quantitative risk analysis of selected biological and chemical agents. To be effective, regulations should be based on specific food safety criteria like FSO (Food Safety Objectives) and PO (Performance objectives). These criteria are defined through risk assessment models and other models which are used for analyses of fit-for-purpose sampling.

This is also the opportunity to presented a new FP7 project PROMISE: "Protection of consumers by microbial risk mitigation through combating segregation of expertise".
